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YARN

Fine Art

1 x 100gm

(photographed in Kingfisher 305)

NEEDLES

1 pair 2mm (no 14) (US 0) needles

TENSION

30 sts and 48 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 2mm (US 0) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed scarf is 12 cm (4½ in) wide and approx 166cm (65in) long.

SCARF

Using 2mm (US 0) needles cast on 35 sts.

Work in g st for 2 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Now work in patt as follows:

Row 1 (RS): K1, *K4, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from * to last 4 sts, K4.

Row 2 and every foll alt row: K2, P to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 3: K3, *K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 5: K2, K2tog, yfwd, *K3, yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, rep from * to last 7 sts, K3, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K2.

Row 7: K4, *yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 9: As row 1.

Row 11: K2, *yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K4, rep from * to last 2 sts, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1.

Row 13: K3, *yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K1, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 15: As row 7.

Row 17: As row 5.

Row 19: As row 11.

Row 20: As row 2.

These 20 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until almost all yarn has been used up, leaving sufficient yarn for another 3 rows and ending with RS facing for next row.

Work in g st for 2 rows.

Cast off.
