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SIZE

To fit age
1-3 3-5 years

YARN

Originally Knitted in RYC Cashsoft Baby DK

A Crocus 808			
1	1	x	50gm
B Horseradish 801			
1	1	x	50gm

Can be substituted for Baby Merino Silk DK

NEEDLES

1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles
1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

TENSION

25 sts and 29 rows to 10 cm measured over patterned stocking stitch using 4mm (US 6) needles.

BERET

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A cast on 118 [134] sts.

Row 1 (RS): *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep this row 6 times more, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Row 8 (WS): Rib 0 [1], *rib 1, inc in next st, rep from * to last 0 [3] sts, rib 0 [3]. 177 [199] sts.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg with a K row, work in st st for 0 [4] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Beg with a K row, using a combination of the **intarsia** and **fairisle** techniques as described on the information page, working end st as indicated and repeating the 22 st patt rep 8 [9] times across rows, cont in patt from chart, which is worked entirely in st st, as follows:

Work 12 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Larger size

Work in st st using yarn A for 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Both sizes

Chart row 13 (RS): Patt 1 st, (patt 20 sts, K2tog) 8 [9] times. 169 [190] sts.

Cont foll chart, dec 1 st at end of every rep of chart as shown and as set by last row, until chart row 46 has been completed, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and thread through rem 9 [10] sts. Pull up tight and fasten off securely.

MAKING UP

Join back seam using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred. Cut a 23 [25] cm diameter circle of card and slip inside beret. Cover with damp cloths and leave to dry naturally.
