YARN

Creative Focus Worsted

A Teal 03360					
4	4	5	5	6	x 100gm
B Evergreen 03112					
2	2	2	2	2	x 100gm

NEEDLES

- 1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles
- 1 pair 4½mm (no 7) (US 7) needles

BUTTONS - 5 x medium sized buttons.

TENSION

20 sts and 24 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 4½mm (US 7) needles.

BACK

Using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A, cast on 110 [120: 132: 144: 158] sts.

****Row 1 (WS):** Using yarn A, knit.

Join in yarn B.

Rows 2 and 3: Using yarn B, knit.

Break off yarn B.

Rows 4 and 5: Using yarn A, knit.

Change to 4 ½mm (US 7) needles.***

Beg with a K row, working in st st throughout, cont as folls:
Cont straight until back meas 13 [14: 15: 17: 18] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.**

Next row (RS): K12 [12: 13: 14: 16], sl 2, K1, p2sso, K3tog, (K10 [12: 14: 16: 18], sl 2, K1, p2sso, K3tog) 5 times, K to end. 86 [96: 108: 120: 134] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Join in yarn B.

Now work in stripe sequence as folls:

Rows 1 and 2: Using yarn B.

Rows 3 to 6: Using yarn A.

Last 6 rows form stripe sequence.

Working in stripe sequence throughout, cont as folls:

Inc 1 st at each end of 7th and foll 17th row.

90 [100: 112: 124: 138] sts.

Cont straight until back meas 34 [35: 36: 37: 38] cm, ending

with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Keeping stripes correct, cast off 5 [6: 7: 8: 9] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 80 [88: 98: 108: 120] sts.

Next row (RS): K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Next row: P1, P2tog, P to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, P1.

76 [84: 94: 104: 116] sts.

Working all decreases as set by last 2 rows, dec 1 st at each end of next 1 [3: 5: 7: 9] rows, then on foll alt row. 72 [76: 82: 88: 96] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 20 [21: 22: 23: 24] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders and back neck

Cast off 6 [6: 7: 8: 9] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

60 [64: 68: 72: 78] sts.

Cast off 6 [6: 7: 8: 9] sts, K until there are 10 [12: 12: 13: 14] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next row.

Cast off rem 5 [7: 7: 8: 9] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin appropriate yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 28 [28: 30: 30: 32] sts, K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

LEFT FRONT

Using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A, cast on 52 [57: 63: 69: 76] sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for back.

Next row (RS): K12 [12: 13: 14: 16], sl 2, K1, p2sso, K3tog, (K10 [12: 14: 16: 18], sl 2, K1, p2sso, K3tog) twice, K to end. 40 [45: 51: 57: 64] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Join in yarn B.

Now working in stripe sequence as given for back throughout, cont as folls:

Inc 1 st at beg of 13th and foll 17th row. 42 [47: 53: 59: 66] sts.

Cont straight until left front matches back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armhole

Keeping stripes correct, cast off 5 [6: 7: 8: 9] sts at beg of next row. 37 [41: 46: 51: 57] sts.

Work 1 row.

Next row (RS): K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, K to end.

Next row: P to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, P1. 35 [39: 44: 49: 55] sts.

Working all decreases as set by last 2 rows, dec 1 st at armhole edge of next 1 [3: 5: 7: 9] rows, then on foll alt row.

33 [35: 38: 41: 45] sts.

Cont until 29 [29: 31: 31: 33] rows less have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Shape front neck

Cast off 6 sts at beg of next row. 27 [29: 32: 35: 39] sts.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 5 rows, then on foll 3 [3: 4: 4: 5] alt rows, then on foll 4th row, then on foll 6th row.

17 [19: 21: 24: 27] sts.

Work 7 rows.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 6 [6: 7: 8: 9] sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 5 [7: 7: 8: 9] sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A, cast on 52 [57: 63: 69: 76] sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for back.

Next row (RS): K2 [3: 4: 5: 6], sl 2, K1, p2sso, K3tog, (K10 [12: 14: 16: 18], sl 2, K1, p2sso, K3tog) twice, K to end. 40 [45: 51: 57: 64] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Join in yarn B.

Now working in stripe sequence as given for back throughout, cont as folls:

Inc 1 st at end of 13th and foll 17th row. 42 [47: 53: 59: 66] sts.

Cont until right front matches back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Shape armhole

Keeping stripes correct, cast off 5 [6: 7: 8: 9] sts at beg of next row. 37 [41: 46: 51: 57] sts.

Next row (RS): K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Next row: P1, P2tog, P to end. 35 [39: 44: 49: 55] sts.

Working all decreases as set by last 2 rows, dec 1 st at armhole edge of next 1 [3: 5: 7: 9] rows, then on foll alt row.

33 [35: 38: 41: 45] sts.

Complete to match left front, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

First sleeve section

Using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A, cast on 24 [25: 26: 26: 27] sts.

Work from ** to *** as given for back.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Next row: P to last 2 sts, K2.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and leave sts on a holder.

Second sleeve section

Using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A, cast on 24 [25: 26: 26: 27] sts.

Work from ** to *** as given for back.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Next row: K2, P to end.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more, ending with RS facing for next row.

Join sections

Next row (RS): Using yarn A only, K24 [25: 26: 26: 27] sts on needle, then K24 [25: 26: 26: 27] sts on holder.

48 [50: 52: 52: 54] sts.

Next row: Purl.

Beg with a K row, working in st st throughout, shape sides by inc 1 st at each end of 3rd [3rd: 3rd: next: next] and 5 [7: 9: 1: 3] foll 4th [4th: 4th: 2nd: 2nd] rows, then on 4 [3: 2: 12: 11] foll 6th [6th: 6th: 4th: 4th] rows. 68 [72: 76: 80: 84] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 31 [32: 33: 33: 33] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top

Cast off 5 [6: 7: 8: 9] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

58 [60: 62: 64: 66] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, then on every foll alt row to 38 sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of 2 foll 4th rows, then foll row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off rem 32 sts.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Neckband

With RS facing, using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn B, beg and ending at front opening edges, pick up and knit 37 [37: 39: 39: 41] sts up right side of neck, 37 [37: 39: 39: 41] sts from back, then 37 [37: 39: 39: 41] sts down left side of neck.

111 [111: 117: 117: 123] sts.

Row 1 (WS): K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 7 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Button band

With RS facing, using 4mm (US6) needles and yarn B, pick up and knit 101 [105: 107: 111: 113] sts evenly down left front opening edge, from top of neckband to cast-on edge.

Beg with row 1, work in rib as given for neckband for 9 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Buttonhole band

Work to match button band, picking up sts up right front opening edge and with the addition of 5 buttonholes worked in row 4 as follows:

Row 4 (RS): K30 [34: 36: 40: 42], *yarn (to make a buttonhole), work 2 tog, rib 14, rep from * 3 times more, yarn (to make 5th buttonhole), work 2 tog, rib to end.
