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Diamond Cuff

YARN

A Pure Wool DK

Shade 002

1 x 50gm

B Kidsilk Haze

Ghost 642

1 x 25gm

NEEDLES

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

EXTRAS

60 cm (23½in) narrow silver ribbon 5 silver sequins

TENSION

20 sts and 28 rows to 10cm measured over st st using 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles and 1 strand each of yarns A and B

FINISHED SIZE

Completed cuff measures 9 cm (3½in) long and 22 cm (8½in) wide.

Using 4mm (US 6) needles and 1 strand each of yarns A an B, cast on 44 sts.

Work 3 rows in g st, ending with **WS** facing for next row. Beg with a P row, work 3 rows in st st, ending with RS facing for next row.

Place chart

Next row (RS): K13, work next 18 sts as row 1 of chart, K13.

Next row: K3, P10, work next 18 sts as row 2 of chart, P10, K3.

These 2 rows set the sts – chart with st st using yarns A and B together at either side.

Keeping chart correct, working rem 10 rows of chart ending with RS facing for next row.

Beg with a K row, work 3 rows in st st, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Work 3 rows in g st. Cast off.

MAKING UP

Using 1 strand of yarn A back stitch all around outside edge of crown.

Using 1 strand of yarn B sew 1 sequin to each point of crown. Thread ribbon through row end edges of cuff to fasten.

K on RS, P on WS using 1 strand each of yarn A and B

K on RS, P on WS using 3 strands of yarn B
