

YARN

Kid Classic

7 7 8 9 x 50gm (photographed in Spruce 853)

NEEDLES

1 pair 5½ mm (no 5) (US 9) needles 4½ mm (no 7) (US 7) circular needles 5½ mm (no 5) (US 9) circular needle Cable needle

TENSION

22 sts and 24 rows to $10~\rm cm$ measured over patt using $5\frac{1}{2}\rm mm$ (US 9) needles.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

C8B = slip next 4 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K4, then K4 from cable needle;

C8F = slip next 4 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K4, then K4 from cable needle;

C16B = slip next 8 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K8, then K8 from cable needle.

BACK

Using 5½mm (US 9) needles cast on 40 sts.

Beg with chart row 1, working chart rows 1 to 12 once only and then repeating chart rows 13 to 28 throughout, work in patt from chart as folls:

Work 1 row, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Inc 1 st at each end of next 8 rows, then on foll 19 [16: 11: 6] alt

rows, then on foll 11 [17: 27: 37] rows, taking inc sts into patt and ending with RS facing for next row. 116 [122: 132: 142] sts.

Cast on 5 [6: 7: 8] sts at beg of next 4 rows.

136 [146: 160: 174] sts.

Cont straight in patt for a further 52 [54: 56: 58] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at each end of next and 8 [7:6:5] foll 4th rows, then on foll 10 [12:14:17] alt rows, then on foll 9 [11:13:15] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

80 [84: 92: 98] sts.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 7 [8: 9: 10] sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 7 [7:8: 9] sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Cast off rem 38 [38: 40: 40] sts.

FRONT

Using 5½mm (US 9) needles cast on 136 [146:160: 174] sts. Beg with chart row **13** and repeating chart rows 13 to 28 throughout, work in patt from chart as folls:

Work 54 [56: 58: 60] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at each end of next and 8 [7: 6: 5] foll 4th rows, then on foll 6 [9: 11: 14] alt rows.

106 [112: 124: 134] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape neck

Next row (RS): Work 2 tog, patt 43 [46: 52: 57] sts and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 8 rows, then on foll 3 [3:4:4] alt rows **and at same time** dec 1 st at side seam edge of 2nd and foll 2 [1:1:1] alt rows, then on foll 9 [11:13:15] rows, ending with RS facing for next row. 21 [23:26:29] sts.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 7 [8: 9: 10] sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 7 [7:8:9] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 16 sts, patt to

last 2 sts, work 2 tog.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the Ball band.

Join side seams for 5 [6: 7: 8] cm from cast-on edge of front using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred. Leave next 23 [24:25:26] cm open (for armhole), then join remainder of side and shoulder seams.

Collar

With RS facing and using 4½mm (US 7) circular needle, pick up and knit 20 [20: 21: 23] sts down left side of neck, 16 sts from front, 20 [20: 21: 23] sts up right side of neck, then 40 [40: 42: 42] sts from back.

96 [96: 100: 104] sts.

Round 1 (RS): *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

This round forms rib.

Cont in rib until collar meas 8 cm from pick-up round.

Change to 5½mm (US 9) circular needle.


Cont in rib until collar meas 16 cm from pick-up round.


Cast off in rib.

Hem border

With RS facing and using 4½mm (US 7) circular needle, beg and ending at base of right side seam, pick up and knit 110 [118: 130: 142] sts from cast-on edge of front, 67 [69:71:73] sts down shaped row-end edge of back to cast-on edge, 32 sts from back cast-on edge, then 67 [69: 71: 73] sts up other shaped row-end edge of back. 276 [288: 304: 320] sts.

Work in rib as given for collar for 6 cm. Cast off in rib. See information page for finishing instructions.
