YARN

Fine Art

A Rowan 314	2	3	3	x 100gm
B Yew 313	2	2	2	x 100gm

NEEDLES

1 pair 2mm (no 14) (US 0) needles (or circular needle if preferred)
 1 pair 2½mm (no 12/13) (US 1) needles (or circular needle if preferred)
 2½mm (no 12/13) (US 1) circular needle 40 cm long

TENSION

32 sts and 38 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 2½mm (US 1) needles.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

triangle 11 = K7 and turn, sl 1, P2 and turn, sl 1, K4 and turn, sl 1, P6 and turn, sl 1, K8 and turn, sl 1, P10 and turn, sl 1, K10. (**Note:** All sts should be slipped with yarn held at **WS** of work – this is back of work on RS rows, and front of work on WS rows.)

Pattern note: When working shaping through patt, if there are insufficient sts to work a complete “triangle 11” work these sts as K sts.

PONCHO (worked in one piece, beg at back hem edge)

Using 2½mm (US 1) needles and yarn A cast on 241 [259: 301] sts.

Joining in yarn B when required, work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): Using yarn A knit.

Row 2: Using yarn A purl.

Rows 3 and 4: As rows 1 and 2.

Row 5: Using yarn B K5 [14: 13], triangle 11, *K11, triangle 11, rep from * to last 5 [14: 13] sts, K5 [14: 13].

Row 6: Using yarn B P5 [14: 13], K11, *P11, K11, rep from *

to last 5 [14: 13] sts, P5 [14: 13].

Rows 7 to 10: As rows 1 and 2, twice.

Row 11: Using yarn B K16 [3: 2], triangle 11, *K11, triangle 11, rep from * to last 16 [3: 2] sts, K16 [3: 2].

Row 12: Using yarn B P16 [3: 2], K11, *P11, K11, rep from * to last 16 [3: 2] sts, P16 [3: 2].

These 12 rows form patt.

Work in patt for a further 114 [120: 132] rows, ending after patt row 6 [12: 12] and with RS facing for next row. (Back should meas approx 33 [35: 38] cm.)

Shape back neck

Next row (RS): Patt 96 [103: 123] sts and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 6 rows.

90 [97: 117] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Place markers at both ends of last row (to denote shoulder fold line row).

Shape right front neck

Work 12 [12: 14] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Inc 1 st at neck edge of next and foll 4th row, then on foll 5 [6: 7] alt rows, then on foll 4 rows, taking inc sts into patt and ending with **WS** facing for next row. 101 [109: 130] sts.

Cast on 39 [40: 40] sts at beg of next row, placing marker on 20th cast-on st (this is centre front st). 140 [149: 170] sts.

Front neck shaping is now complete.

Work 16 [18: 22] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape front opening edge

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at end of next and 3 foll 4th rows, then on foll 10 alt rows, then at same edge on foll 33 rows.

93 [102: 123] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next and foll alt row, 4 sts at beg of foll alt row, 5 sts at beg of foll alt row, 6 sts at beg of foll 2 alt rows, 8 sts at beg of foll 2 [3: 3] alt rows, then 10 sts at beg of foll 2 [2: 4] alt rows, ending after 4 rows using yarn A and with RS facing for next row.

Cast off rem 30 [31: 32] sts.

With RS facing, slip centre 49 [53: 55] sts onto a holder placing a marker on centre st of these sts (this is centre back neck st), rejoin yarn A and K to end. 96 [103: 123] sts.

Shape back neck

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 6 rows. 90 [97: 117] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Place markers at both ends of last row (to denote shoulder fold line row).

Shape left front neck

Work 13 [13: 15] rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Inc 1 st at neck edge of next and foll 4th row, then on foll 5 [6: 7] alt rows, then on foll 4 rows, taking inc sts into patt and ending with RS facing for next row. 101 [109: 130] sts.

Cast on 39 [40: 40] sts at beg of next row, placing marker on 20th cast-on st (this is centre front st). 140 [149: 170] sts.

Front neck shaping is now complete.

Work 15 [17: 21] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape front opening edge

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at beg of next and 3 foll 4th rows, then on foll 10 alt rows, then at same edge on foll 33 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. 93 [102: 123] sts.

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next and foll alt row, 4 sts at beg of foll alt row, 5 sts at beg of foll alt row, 6 sts at beg of foll 2 alt rows, 8 sts at beg of foll 2 [3: 3] alt rows, then 10 sts at beg of foll 2 [2: 4] alt rows.

Work 1 row, ending after 4 rows using yarn A and with RS facing for next row.

Cast off rem 30 [31: 32] sts.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Side borders (both alike)

With RS facing, using 2mm (US 0) needles and yarn A, pick up and knit 249 [259: 281] sts evenly along side (straight) row-end edge, between cast-on and cast-off edges.

Row 1 (WS): K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K2, *P1, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for 1 row more, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Back hem border

With RS facing, using 2mm (US 0) needles and yarn A, pick up and knit 249 [267: 309] sts evenly along entire back (cast-on) edge, between cast-off edges of side borders.

Work in rib as given for side borders for 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Right front and hem border

With RS facing, using 2mm (US 0) needles and yarn A, beg at cast-off edge of side band, pick up and knit 34 [35: 36] sts along lower edge to end of final cast-off edge, 72 [113: 136] sts along shaped cast-off edge to last dec, 67 sts along shaped row-end edge to first dec, then 16 [18: 22] sts up straight row-end edge to neck shaping. 189 [233: 261] sts.

Work in rib as given for side borders for 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Left front and hem border

Work to match right front and hem border, picking up sts in reverse order.

Lay right front over left front so that centre front markers match at neck edge (fronts should overlap by 39 [40: 40] sts plus the borders). Sew both layers together where they meet along front neck edge – when picking up sts for collar, ensure both layers are worked through across this double-thickness edge.

Collar

With RS facing, using 2½mm (US 1) circular needle and yarn A, beg at marked centre back st, K centre back st, then K rem 24 [26: 27] sts of left side of back neck inc 0 [1: 0] st evenly across, pick up and knit 7 sts up left side of back neck to shoulder marker, 30 [35: 35] sts down left side of front neck, 39 [41: 41] sts from front, 30 [35: 35] sts up right side of front neck to shoulder marker, and 7 sts down right side of back neck, then K across rem 24 [26: 27] sts of right side of back neck inc 0 [1: 0] st evenly across. 162 [180: 180] sts.

Now K the marked centre back st again and turn work, so that WS of body now becomes RS of collar – marked centre back st is first st of every round.

Joining in yarn B when required, shape collar as follows:

Rounds 1 to 3: Using yarn A knit.

Round 4: Using yarn A knit to end, then K marked centre back st and next 4 sts of round again.

Round 5: Using yarn B (K7, triangle 11) 9 [10: 10] times.

Round 6: Using yarn B (K7, P11) 9 [10: 10] times.

Round 7: Using yarn A K to marked centre back st.

Round 8: Using yarn A knit.

Round 9: Using yarn A (K18, M1) 9 [10: 10] times. 171 [190: 190] sts.

Round 10: Using yarn A knit.

Round 11: Using yarn B K3, (triangle 11, K8) 8 [9: 9] times, triangle 11, K5.

Round 12: Using yarn B K3, (P11, K8) 8 [9: 9] times, P11, K5.

Rounds 13 to 15: Using yarn A knit.

Round 16: Using yarn A M1 and move centre back marker onto this st, K19, (M1, K19) 8 [9: 9] times, then K marked centre back st and next 4 sts of round again. 180 [200: 200] sts.

Round 17: Using yarn B (K9, triangle 11) 9 [10: 10] times.

Round 18: Using yarn B (K9, P11) 9 [10: 10] times.

Round 19: Using yarn A K to marked centre back st.

Rounds 20 to 22: Using yarn A knit.

Round 23: Using yarn B K4, (triangle 11, K9) 8 [9: 9] times, triangle 11, K5.

Round 24: Using yarn B K4, (P11, K9) 8 [9: 9] times, P11, K5.

Rounds 25 to 27: Using yarn A knit.

Round 28: Using yarn A knit to end, then K marked centre back st and next 4 sts of round again.

Rounds 29 to 31: As rounds 17 to 19.

Round 32: Using yarn A (K20, M1) 9 [10: 10] times. 189 [210: 210] sts.

Rounds 33 and 34: Using yarn A knit.

Round 35: Using yarn B K4, (triangle 11, K10) 8 [9: 9] times, triangle 11, K6.

Round 36: Using yarn B K4, (P11, K10) 8 [9: 9] times, P11, K6.

Rounds 37 and 38: Using yarn A knit.

Round 39: Using yarn A M1 and move centre back marker onto this st, K21, (M1, K21) 8 [9: 9] times. 198 [220: 220] sts.

These 39 rounds complete collar shaping.

Now work in patt as follows:

Round 1: Using yarn A knit to end, then K marked centre back st and next 4 sts of round again.

Round 2: Using yarn B (K11, triangle 11) 9 [10: 10] times.

Round 3: Using yarn B (K11, P11) 9 [10: 10] times.

Round 4: Using yarn A K to marked centre back st.

Rounds 5 to 7: Using yarn A knit.

Round 8: Using yarn B K5, (triangle 11, K11) 8 [9: 9] times, triangle 11, K6.

Round 9: Using yarn B K5, (P11, K11) 8 [9: 9] times, P11, K6.

Rounds 10 to 12: Using yarn A knit.

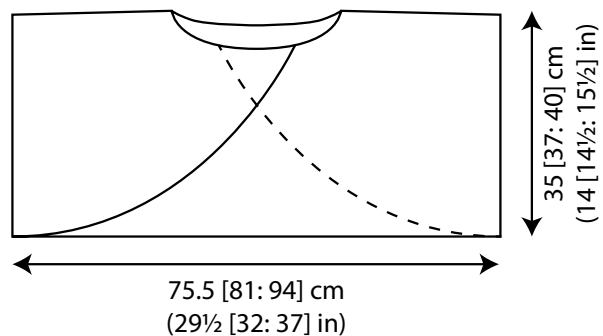
Last 12 rounds form patt.

Work in patt for a further 30 rounds, ending after 2 rounds using yarn A.

Break off yarn B and cont using yarn A **only**.

Next round: *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep this round 3 times more.
Cast off loosely in rib.
