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YARN

Cocoon

A Umber	835	10 x 100gm
B Clay	825	4 x 100gm
C Bilberry	812	3 x 100gm
D Scree	803	4 x 100gm
E Alpine	802	3 x 100gm
F Misty Blue	827	2 x 100gm
G Moon	836	2 x 100gm

CROCHET HOOK

7.00mm (no 2) (US K10½) crochet hook

TENSION

All patches meas 13 cm wide and vary in length according to instructions, using 7.00mm (US K10½) crochet hook.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed throw measures approx 132 cm (52 in) wide and 202 cm (79½ in) long.

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc(s)** = double crochet(s); **dtr** = double treble; **htr** = half treble; **tr(s)** = treble(s); **tr2tog** = (yoh and insert hook as indicated, yoh and draw loop through, yoh and draw through 2 loops) twice, yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook; **tr3tog** = (yoh and insert hook as indicated, yoh and draw loop through, yoh and draw through 2 loops) 3 times, yoh and draw through all 4 loops on hook; **sp(s)** = space(s); **ss** = slip stitch; **trtr** = triple treble.

PATCH A (make 9)

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Rows 1 and 2: Using yarn A.

Row 3: Using yarn D.

Rows 4 and 5: Using yarn E.

Row 6: Using yarn A.

Rows 7 and 8: Using yarn D.

Row 9: Using yarn E.

These 9 rows form stripe sequence and are repeated throughout this patch.

Using 7.00mm (US K10½) crochet hook and yarn A make 24 ch.

Row 1 (RS): 2 dc into 2nd ch from hook, *1 dc into each of next 4 ch, miss 2 ch, 1 dc into each of next 4 ch**, 3 dc into next ch, rep from * to end, ending last rep at **, 2 dc into last ch, turn. 23 sts.

Row 2: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 2 dc into first st, *1 dc into each of next 4 dc, miss 2 dc, 1 dc into each of next 4 dc**, 3 dc into next dc, rep from * to end, ending last rep at **, 2 dc into last dc, turn.

Joining in and breaking off colours as required and beg with stripe sequence row 3 (see above), rep row 2 until patch meas 32 cm.

Fasten off.

PATCH B (make 9)

Work as given for patch A until patch meas 19 cm.

Fasten off.

PATCH C (make 15)

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Row 1: Using yarn B.

Row 2: Using yarn A.

Row 3: Using yarn C.

These 3 rows form stripe sequence and are repeated throughout this patch.

Using 7.00mm (US K10½) crochet hook and yarn B make 17 ch.

Row 1 (WS): 1 htr into 3rd ch from hook, *miss 1 ch, (1 htr, 1 ch, 1 htr) into next ch, rep from * to last 2 ch, miss 1 ch, 2 htr into last ch, turn. 22 sts.

Joining in and breaking off colours as required, now work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): Using yarn A, 3 ch, 1 tr into st at base of 3 ch, (counts as tr2tog), *1 ch, tr3tog into next ch sp, rep from * until tr3tog has been worked into last ch sp, 1 ch, tr2tog into top of 2 ch at beg of previous row, turn. (7 ch sps).

Row 2: Using yarn C, 2 ch (counts as first htr), miss tr at base of 2 ch, *(1 htr, 1 ch, 1 htr) into next ch sp, rep from * until (1 htr, 1 ch, 1 htr) has been worked into last ch sp, 1 htr into top of 3 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

Row 3: Using yarn B, 3 ch (counts as first tr), miss htr at base of 3 ch and next htr, *tr3tog into next ch sp, 1 ch, rep from * until tr3tog has been worked into last ch sp, 1 ch, 1 tr into top of 2 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

Row 4: Using yarn A, 2 ch (counts as first htr), 1 htr into st at base of 2 ch, *(1 htr, 1 ch, 1 htr) into next ch sp, rep from * until (1 htr, 1 ch, 1 htr) has been worked into last ch sp, 1 htr into top of 3 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

These 4 rows form patt.

Beg with stripe sequence row 3 (see above), cont in patt until patch meas 32 cm.

Fasten off.

PATCH D (make 3)

Work as given for patch C until patch meas 19 cm.

Fasten off.

PATCH E (make 9)

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Row 1: Using yarn F.

Row 2: Using yarn D.

Row 3: Using yarn G.

These 3 rows form stripe sequence and are repeated throughout this patch.

Using 7.00mm (US K10½) crochet hook and yarn F make 15 ch.

Row 1 (RS): 1 tr into 4th ch from hook, 1 tr into each ch to end, turn. 13 sts.

Joining in and breaking off colours as required, now work in patt as folls:

Row 1: Using yarn D, 3 ch (counts as first tr), miss tr at base of 3 ch, 1 tr into each tr to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

Last row forms tr fabric.

Beg with stripe sequence row 3 (see above), cont in tr fabric until patch meas 32 cm.

Fasten off.

PATCH F (make 9)

Work as given for patch E until patch meas 19 cm.

Fasten off.

PATCH G (make 9)

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Row 1: Using yarn A.

Row 2: Using yarn C.

Row 3: Using yarn B.

Row 4: Using yarn G.

Row 5: Using yarn F.

Row 6: Using yarn A.

These 6 rows form stripe sequence and are repeated throughout this patch.

Using 7.00mm (US K10½) crochet hook and yarn A make 21 ch.

Row 1 (RS): 2 tr into 3rd ch from hook, *miss 3 ch, 1 dc into next ch, 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 3 ch, rep from * to last 4 ch, miss 3 ch, 1 dc into last ch, turn. 16 sts.

Joining in and breaking off colours as required, now work in patt as folls:

Row 1: 3 ch (counts as first tr), 2 tr into st at base of 3 ch *miss 3 tr, 1 dc into first of 3 ch, 3 ch, 1 tr into each of next 2 ch, 1 tr into next dc, rep from * to last 3 sts, miss 2 tr, 1 dc into top of 2 ch at beg of last row, turn.

Last row forms patt.

Beg with stripe sequence row 3 (see above), cont in patt until patch meas 32 cm.

Fasten off.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join patches into strips

Following diagram, with **WS** facing, using 7.00mm (US K10 ½) crochet hook and yarn A, join patches into strips by working trs into one patch and dcs into corresponding sts on other patch, working the “zig-zag” edges of patch A as folls:

Patch A outside edge

With **WS** facing, using 7.00mm (US K10½) crochet hook and yarn A, attach yarn to corner (fasten off edge) of patch A and work as folls:

Row 1 (WS): 1 ch (does NOT count as a st), 1 dc into first st, *1 tr into next dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, 1 dtr into next dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, 1 trtr into next dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, 1 dtr into next dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, 1 tr into next dc, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, 1 dc into next dc*, 1 ch, miss 1 dc, rep from * to * once more.

Fasten off.

Join patch C to patch A

With **WS** facing, using 7.00mm (US K10½) crochet hook and yarn A, attach yarn to corner (foundation chain edge) of patch A. Working into foundation chain of patch A and last row of patch C cont as folls:

Row 1 (WS): 5 ch (counts as 1 trtr), 1 dc into first st of patch C, *1 dtr into next ch on patch A, 1 dc into corresponding st of patch C, miss 1 ch on patch A, 1 tr into next ch on patch A, 1 dc into corresponding st of patch C, miss 1 ch on patch

A, 1 dc into next ch on patch A, 1 dc into corresponding st of patch C, miss 1 ch on patch A, 1 tr into next ch on patch A, 1 dc into corresponding st of patch C, miss 1 ch on patch A, 1 dtr into next ch on patch A, 1 dc into corresponding st of patch C, miss 1 ch on patch A, 1 trtr into next ch on patch A, 1 dc into corresponding st of patch C*, miss 1 ch on patch A, rep from * to * once more.

Fasten off.

Join another patch A to patch C by working sts as given for outside edge into patch A and dcs into corresponding sts of patch C.

Following diagram, cont joining patches into strips until there are 9 strips.

Following diagram, with **WS** facing, using 7.00mm (US K10 ½) crochet hook and yarn A, join strips by working trs into one strip and dcs into corresponding sts on other strip.

Edging

with **RS** facing, using 7.00mm (US K10½) crochet hook and yarn A, attach yarn along one side of joined patches, 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), miss st at base of 3 ch, now work one round of tr evenly around entire outer edge of joined patches, working 5 tr into each corner and ss to top of 3 ch at beg of round. Fasten off.
