


## Sparkling Wreath By Pauline Ellis

## Sparkling Wreath

Make a selection of different sized pom poms using brushed fleece, anchor artiste metallic and fur.

Then cut out a card ring and wrap it with some inch wide white ribbon to cover the card, then stick the pom poms to the ring.

To make the hanging loop, crochet a length of chain of approx 40cm and attached to the back of the wreath.
