## YARN

## All Seasons Cotton

$29 \times 50 \mathrm{gm}$
(photographed in Iceberg 192)

## NEEDLES

1 pair 5 mm (no 6) (US 8) needles

## TENSION

17 sts and 24 rows to 10 cm meas over st st using 5 mm (US 8) needles.

## FINISHED SIZE

Completed throw measures 144 cm ( 57 ins ) by 160 cm (63 ins).

PANEL A (MAKE 28)
Using 5mm (US 8) needles cast on 35 sts.
Now work from chart for Panel A as folls:
Work all 48 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.
Cast off.

PANEL B (MAKE 28)
Using 5 mm (US 8) needles cast on 35 sts.
Now work from chart for Panel B as folls:
Work all 48 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.

## MAKING UP

Press lightly on WS following instruction on ball band. Using back stitch or mattress stitch if preferred, beg with panel A and join alternate panels together to make a 7 wide panel strip. Make 4 of these strips. Then beg with panel B and again join alternate panels together to make another 7 panel wide strip. Make 4 of these strips. Alternating strips, join together until all 8 strips have been joined to make up the throw.
