NEEDLES
1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles
1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

BUTTONS – 2 x 75324 for 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th sizes only

ZIP – open-ended zip to fit

TENSION
Before washing 20 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over stocking stitch using 4mm (US 6) needles.

Tension note: Denim will shrink in length when washed for the first time. Allowances have been made in this pattern for shrinkage (see size diagram for after washing measurements).

BACK
Cast on 51 (57: 61: 67: 63: 69: 73: 79: 83: 89) sts using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.
Row 1 (RS): K0 (1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1), *P1, K1, rep from * to last 1 (0: 0: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0) st, P1 (0: 0: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0).
Row 2: As row 1.

These 2 rows form moss st.
Work in moss st for a further 8 rows, ending with a WS row.
Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.
Beg with a K row, work in st st as folls:
5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th sizes only
Inc 1 st at each end of - (-: -: -: 3rd: 3rd: 3rd: 3rd: 5th: 5th) and every foll - (-: -: -: 8th: 8th: 10th: 10th: 12th: 12th) row until there are - (-: -: -: 71: 77: 81: 87: 91: 97) sts.

All sizes
Cont straight until back measures 14.5 (15.5: 17: 18: 19: 21.5: 24: 26.5: 29: 31) cm, ending with a WS row.

Shape armholes
Cast off 3 (3: 3: 3: 4: 4: 4: 4: 4: 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows.
45 (51: 55: 61: 63: 69: 73: 79: 83: 89) sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 (3: 3: 3: 4: 4: 4: 6: 6: 6) rows. 39 (45: 49: 55: 55: 61: 65: 67: 71: 77) sts.
Cont straight until armhole measures 14.5 (15.5: 17: 18: 19: 20.5: 21.5: 23: 24: 25) cm, ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulders and back neck
Cast off 3 (4: 5: 5: 5: 6: 7: 7: 8) sts at beg of next 2 rows.
33 (37: 39: 45: 45: 49: 51: 53: 57: 61) sts.

Next row (RS): Cast off 3 (4: 5: 5: 5: 6: 7: 7: 8) sts, K until there are 7 (8: 8: 10: 10: 11: 10: 11: 12: 13) sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.
Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row.
Cast off rem 3 (4: 4: 6: 6: 7: 6: 7: 8: 9) sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 13 (13: 13: 15: 15: 15: 17: 17: 19: 19) sts, K to end.
Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

POCKET LININGS (make 2)
5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th sizes only
Cast on - (-: -: -: 20: 20: 22: 22: 24: 24) sts using 4mm (US 6) needles.
Beg with a K row, work in st st for 28 rows.

Break yarn and leave sts on a holder.

LEFT FRONT
Cast on 26 (29: 31: 34: 32: 35: 37: 40: 42: 45) sts using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.
Row 1 (RS): K0 (1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1), *P1, K1, rep from * to end.
Row 2: *K1, P1, rep from * to last 0 (1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1) st, K0 (1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1).
These 2 rows form moss st.
Work in moss st for a further 8 rows, ending with a WS row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Next row: K1, P to end.

These 2 rows set the sts – front opening edge st worked as a K st on every row with all other sts in st st.

Keeping sts correct as set, cont as folls:

5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th sizes only

Inc 1 st at beg of – (-: -: -: next: next: next: next: 3rd: 3rd) and every foll – (-: -: -: 8th: 8th: 10th: 10th: 12th: 12th) row until there are – (-: -: -: 36: 39: 41: 44: 46: 49) sts.

All sizes

Cont straight until left front matches back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with a WS row.

Shape armhole

Cast off 3 (3: 3: 3: 4: 4: 4: 4: 4: 4) sts at beg of next row. 23 (26: 28: 31: 32: 35: 37: 40: 42: 45) sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at armhole edge of next 3 (3: 3: 3: 4: 4: 4: 6: 6: 6) rows. 20 (23: 25: 28: 28: 31: 33: 34: 36: 39) sts.

5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th sizes only

Cont straight until armhole measures – (-: -: -: 6: 6: 7: 7: 8: 8) cm, ending with a WS row.

Place pocket

Next row (RS): K- (-: -: -: 4: 6: 6: 6: 8), slip next – (-: -: -: 20: 20: 22: 22: 24: 24) sts onto a holder and, in their place, K across – (-: -: -: 20: 20: 22: 22: 24: 24) sts of first pocket lining, K- (-: -: -: 4: 5: 5: 6: 6: 7).

All sizes

Cont straight until 11 (11: 11: 11: 13: 13: 13: 13: 13: 13) rows less have been worked than on back to start of shoulder shaping, ending with a RS row.

Shape neck

Cast off 6 (6: 6: 7: 6: 7: 8: 8) sts at beg of next row. 14 (17: 19: 21: 22: 25: 26: 27: 28: 31) sts.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 3 rows, then on foll 2 (2: 2: 2: 3: 3: 3: 3: 3) alt rows. 9 (12: 14: 16: 16: 19: 20: 21: 22: 25) sts.

Work 3 rows, ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 3 (4: 5: 5: 5: 6: 7: 7: 7: 8) sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 3 (4: 4: 6: 6: 7: 6: 7: 8: 9) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Cast on 26 (29: 31: 34: 32: 35: 37: 40: 42: 45) sts using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Row 1 (RS): *K1, P1, rep from * to last 0 (1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1) st, K0 (1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1).

Row 2: K0 (1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1), *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form moss st.

Work in moss st for a further 8 rows, ending with a WS row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Next row: P to last st, K1.

These 2 rows set the sts – front opening edge st worked as a K st on every row with all other sts in st st.

Keeping sts correct as set, cont as folls:

5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th sizes only

Inc 1 st at end of – (-: -: -: next: next: next: next: 3rd: 3rd) and every foll – (-: -: -: 8th: 8th: 10th: 10th: 12th: 12th) row until there are – (-: -: -: 36: 39: 41: 44: 46: 49) sts.

All sizes

Complete to match left front, reversing shapings and placing pocket for **5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th sizes only** as folls:

Next row (RS): K- (-: -: -: 4: 5: 5: 6: 6: 7), slip next – (-: -: -: 20: 20: 22: 22: 24: 24) sts onto a holder and, in their place, K across – (-: -: -: 20: 20: 22: 22: 24: 24) sts of second pocket lining, K- (-: -: -: 4: 6: 6: 6: 8).

LEFT SLEEVE

1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th sizes only

Cast on 29 (31: 33: 35: -: -: -: -:) sts using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: As row 1.

These 2 rows form moss st.

Work in moss st for a further 6 rows, ending with a WS row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th sizes only

Front cuff/sleeve

Cast on – (-: -: -: 29: 29: 31: 31: 33: 33) sts using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: As row 1.

These 2 rows form moss st.

Work in moss st for a further 4 rows, ending with a WS row.

Row 7 (RS): K1, P2tog, yrn (to make a buttonhole), moss st to end.

Work in moss st for a further 3 rows, ending with a WS row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Next row (RS): Moss st 5 sts, K to end.

Next row: P to last 5 sts, moss st 5 sts.

These 2 rows set the sts – 5 sts still in moss st for cuff opening border and rem sts in st st.

Keeping sts correct as set, inc 1 st at end of next and foll – (-: -: -: 6th: 6th: 8th: 8th: 8th: 8th) row. – (-: -: -: 31: 31: 33: 33: 35: 35) sts.

Work a further – (-: -: -: 5: 5: 5: 5: 7: 7) rows, ending with a WS row.

Break yarn and leave sts on a holder.

Back cuff/sleeve

Cast on – (-: -: -: 13: 13: 15: 15: 17: 17) sts using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Work in moss st as given for front cuff/sleeve for 10 rows, ending with a WS row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Next row (RS): K to last 5 sts, moss st 5 sts.

Next row: Moss st 5 sts, P to end.

These 2 rows set the sts – 5 sts still in moss st for cuff opening border and rem sts in st st.

Keeping sts correct as set, inc 1 st at beg of next and foll – (-: -: -: 6th: 6th: 8th: 8th: 8th: 8th) row. – (-: -: -: 15: 15: 17: 17: 19: 19) sts.

Work a further – (-: -: -: 5: 5: 5: 5: 7: 7) rows, ending with a WS row.

Join sections

Next row (RS): Working across sts of back cuff/sleeve, (inc in first st) – (-: -: -: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1) times, K to last 5 sts, now holding WS of front cuff/sleeve against RS of back cuff/sleeve, K tog first st of front cuff/sleeve with next st of back cuff/sleeve, in same way K tog next 4 sts of front cuff/sleeve with rem 4 sts of back cuff/sleeve, working across rem sts of front cuff/sleeve, K to last – (-: -: -: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1) st, (inc in last st) – (-: -: -: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1) times. – (-: -: -: 43: 43: 45: 45: 51: 51) sts.

****All sizes**

Beg with a K (K: K: K: P: P: P: P: P) row, now work in st st, shapng sides by inc 1 st at each end of 3rd (3rd: 3rd: 3rd: 6th: 6th: 2nd: 2nd: 8th: 8th) and every foll 4th (6th: 6th: 6th: 6th: 6th: 8th: 6th: 8th: 8th) row to 47 (39: 49: 57: 57: 65: 49: 75: 61: 59) sts, then on every foll – (4th: 4th: 4th: 4th: 4th: 6th: -: 6th: 6th) row until there are – (51: 55: 59: 63: 67: 71: -: 79: 83) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 18 (21.5: 25: 29: 32.5: 36: 39.5: 43: 47: 50.5) cm, ending with a WS row.

Shape top

Cast off 3 (3: 3: 3: 4: 4: 4: 4: 4: 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 41 (45: 49: 53: 55: 59: 63: 67: 71: 75) sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and foll 3 (3: 3: 3: 4: 4: 5: 5: 5) alt rows.

Work 1 row, ending with a WS row.

Cast off rem 33 (37: 41: 45: 45: 49: 53: 55: 59: 63) sts.

RIGHT SLEEVE

1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th sizes only

Work as given for left sleeve.

5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th sizes only

Back cuff/sleeve

Cast on – (-: -: -: 13: 13: 15: 15: 17: 17) sts using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Work in moss st as given for left sleeve for 10 rows, ending with a WS row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Next row (RS): Moss st 5 sts, K to end.

Next row: P to last 5 sts, moss st 5 sts.

These 2 rows set the sts – 5 sts still in moss st for cuff opening border and rem sts in st st.

Keeping sts correct as set, inc 1 st at end of next and foll – (-: -: -: 6th: 6th: 8th: 8th: 8th: 8th) row. – (-: -: -: 15: 15: 17: 17: 19: 19) sts.

Work a further – (-: -: -: 5: 5: 5: 5: 7: 7) rows, ending with a WS row.

Break yarn and leave sts on a holder.

Front cuff/sleeve

Cast on – (-: -: -: 29: 29: 31: 31: 33: 33) sts using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Work in moss st as given for left sleeve for 6 rows, ending with a WS row.

Row 7 (RS): Moss st to last 3 sts, yrn (to make a buttonhole), P2tog, K1.

Work in moss st for a further 3 rows, ending with a WS row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Next row (RS): K to last 5 sts, moss st 5 sts.

Next row: Moss st 5 sts, P to end.

These 2 rows set the sts – 5 sts still in moss st for cuff opening border and rem sts in st st.

Keeping sts correct as set, inc 1 st at beg of next and foll – (-: -: -: 6th: 6th: 8th: 8th: 8th: 8th) row. – (-: -: -: 31: 31: 33: 33: 35: 35) sts.

Work a further – (-: -: -: 5: 5: 5: 5: 7: 7) rows, ending with a WS row.

Join sections

Next row (RS): Working across sts of front cuff/sleeve, (inc in first st)

- (-: -: -: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1) times, K to last 5 sts, now holding RS of back cuff/sleeve against WS of front cuff/sleeve, K tog next st of front cuff/sleeve with first st of back cuff/sleeve, in same way K tog rem 4 sts of front cuff/sleeve with next 4 sts of back cuff/sleeve, working across rem sts of back cuff/sleeve, K to last - (-: -: -: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1) st, (inc in last st) - (-: -: -: 1: 1: 0: 0: 1: 1) times.
 - (-: -: -: 43: 43: 45: 45: 51: 51) sts.
 Complete as given for left sleeve from **.

MAKING UP

DO NOT PRESS.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress st if preferred.

Collar

Cast on 63 (63: 63: 67: 71: 71: 75: 75: 79: 79) sts using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.
 Work in moss st as given for left sleeve for 8 (8: 8: 8: 10: 10: 12: 12: 12) cm.
 Cast off in moss st.

5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th sizes only

Pocket tops (both alike)

Slip - (-: -: -: 20: 20: 22: 22: 24: 24) sts left on pocket holder onto 3¼mm (US 3) needles and rejoin yarn with RS facing.

Row 1 (RS): *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Rep these 2 rows twice more.

Cast off in moss st.

All sizes

Machine wash all pieces as described on the ball band before completing garment.

Sewing cast-on edge of collar to neck edge and setting in sleeves using the shallow set-in method. Insert zip into front opening.
