NEEDLES

1 pair 2¼mm (no 12) (US 2) needles
1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles

BUTTONS - 5

TENSION

27 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

BACK

Using 2¼mm (US 2) needles and yarn A cast on 135 [147: 163: 181] sts. Beg with a K row, work in st st for 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Row 5 (picot row) (RS): K1, *yfwd, K2tog, rep from * to end. Beg with a P row, work in st st for 25 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break off yarn A and join in yarn B.

Work in st st for a further 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K8, sl 1, K1, pss0, K to last 10 sts, K2tog, K8.

Working all side seam decreases as set by last row, dec 1 st at each end of 20th and 3 foll 20th rows. 125 [137: 153: 171] sts.

Cont straight until back meas 37 [38: 39: 40] cm **from picot row**, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape raglan armholes

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 119 [131: 147: 165] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 1 [7: 17: 33] rows, then on 1 [0: 0: 0] foll 4th row, then on every foll alt row until 51 [51: 53: 53] sts rem. Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off.

LEFT FRONT

Using 2¼mm (US 2) needles and yarn A cast on 67 [73: 81: 90] sts. Beg with a K row, work in st st for 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Row 5 (picot row) (RS): K1, *yfwd, K2tog, rep from * to last 0 [0: 0: 1] st, K0 [0: 0: 1].

Beg with a P row, work in st st for 25 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break off yarn A and join in yarn B.

Work in st st for a further 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K8, sl 1, K1, pss0, K to end.

Working all side seam decreases as set by last row, dec 1 st at beg of 20th and 3 foll 20th rows. 62 [68: 76: 85] sts.

Cont straight until left front matches back to beg of raglan armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape raglan armhole

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row. 59 [65: 73: 82] sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at raglan armhole edge of next 1 [7: 17: 33] rows, then on 1 [0: 0: 0] foll 4th row, then on every foll alt row until 34 [34: 36: 36] sts rem, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Shape front neck

Cast off 18 sts at beg of next row. 16 [16: 18: 18] sts.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 9 rows, then on foll 0 [0: 1: 1] alt row **and at same time** dec 1 st at raglan armhole edge of next and foll 4 [4: 5: 5] alt rows. 2 sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K2tog and fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 2¼mm (US 2) needles and yarn A cast on 67 [73: 81: 90] sts. Beg with a K row, work in st st for 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Row 5 (picot row) (RS): K1 [1: 1: 2], *yfwd, K2tog, rep from * to end.

Beg with a P row, work in st st for 25 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break off yarn A and join in yarn B.

Work in st st for a further 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K to last 10 sts, K2tog, K8.

Working all side seam decreases as set by last row, complete to match left front, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using 2¼mm (US 2) needles and yarn A cast on 165 [171: 177: 179] sts. Beg with a K row, work in st st for 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 3¼mm (US 3) needles.

Row 5 (picot row) (RS): K1, *yfwd, K2tog, rep from * to end.

Beg with a P row, work in st st for 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K8, sl 1, K1, pssso, K to last 10 sts, K2tog, K8.

Working all decreases as set by last row, dec 1 st at each end of 2nd and foll 9 alt rows. 143 [149: 155: 157] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break off yarn A and join in yarn B.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and foll 13 alt rows, then on 4 [5: 6: 6] foll 4th rows. 107 [111: 115: 117] sts.

Work 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. (Sleeve should meas 20 [21: 22: 22] cm **from picot row.**)

Shape raglan

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 101 [105: 109: 111] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 13 rows, then on every foll alt row until 27 sts rem.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Left sleeve only

Dec 1 st at each end of next row, then cast off 4 sts at beg of foll row. 21 sts.

Dec 1 st at beg of next row, then cast off 5 sts at beg of foll row. 15 sts.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 9 sts.

Dec 1 st at beg of next row, then cast off 4 sts at beg of foll row.

Right sleeve only

Cast off 5 sts at beg and dec 1 st at end of next row. 21 sts.

Work 1 row.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. 9 sts.

Cast off 4 sts at beg and dec 1 st at end of next row.

Work 1 row.

Both sleeves

Cast off rem 4 sts.

MAKING UP

Press.

Join all raglan seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Neckband

With RS facing, using 2¼mm (US 2) needles and yarn A, beg and ending at front opening edges, pick up and knit 27 [27: 29: 29] sts up right side of neck, 19 sts from top of right sleeve, 49 [49: 51: 51] sts from back, 19 sts from top of left sleeve, then 27 [27: 29: 29] sts down left side of neck. 141 [141: 147: 147] sts.

Row 1 (WS): K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K2, *P1, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Button band

With RS facing, using 2¼mm (US 2) needles and yarn A, beg at cast-off edge of neckband, pick up and knit 157 [165: 169: 173] sts evenly down left front opening edge, ending at picot row.

Beg with row 1, work in rib as given for neckband for 5 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Buttonhole band

With RS facing, using 2¼mm (US 2) needles and yarn A, beg at picot row, pick up and knit 157 [165: 169: 173] sts evenly up right front opening edge, ending at cast-off edge of neckband.

Beg with row 1, work in rib as given for neckband for 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Row 2 (RS): Rib 4, *yrn, work 2 tog (to make a buttonhole), rib 35 [37: 38: 39], rep from * 3 times more, yrn, work 2 tog (to make 5th buttonhole), rib 3.

Work in rib for a further 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Fold first 4 rows of body and sleeves to inside along picot row and neatly sew in place.
