## SIZE

## YARN

Rowan Wool Cotton

A Inky 908	5	5	6	6	6	x	50gm
B Misty 903	4	4	4	5	5	x	50gm

## NEEDLES

1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

## DECORATION

**Buttons** - 3 x 75320, and 7 x 75321

Oddments of embroidery threads in contrast colours

## TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm measured over stocking stitch using 4mm (US 6) needles.

## BACK

Cast on 79 (85: 91: 97: 103) sts using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1 (0: 2: 0: 0), P2 (1: 2: 2: 0), \*K3, P2, rep from \* to last 1 (4: 2: 0: 3) sts, K1 (3: 2: 0: 3), P0 (1: 0: 0: 0).

**Row 2:** P1 (0: 2: 0: 0), K2 (1: 2: 2: 0), \*P3, K2, rep from \* to last 1 (4: 2: 0: 3) sts, P1 (3: 2: 0: 3), K0 (1: 0: 0: 0).

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 18 rows, end with a WS row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg with a K row, work in striped st st as folls:

Using yarn A work 2 rows.

Using yarn B work 4 rows.

Using yarn A work 2 rows.

Last 8 rows form striped st st.

Keeping stripes correct, inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll

8th row to 85 (91: 97: 103: 109) sts, then on every foll 6th row until there are 91 (97: 103: 109: 115) sts.

Cont straight until back measures 26 (27: 27: 28: 28) cm, ending with a WS row.

## Shape armholes

Cast off 4 (5: 5: 6: 6) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 83 (87: 93: 97: 103) sts. Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 (5: 7: 7: 9) rows, then on foll 2 (3: 3: 4: 4) alt rows. 69 (71: 73: 75: 77) sts.

Cont straight until armhole measures 19 (19: 20: 20: 21) cm, ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulders and back neck

Cast off 6 (6: 7: 7: 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 57 (59: 59: 61: 63) sts.

**Next row (RS):** Cast off 6 (6: 7: 7: 7) sts, K until there are 11 (11: 10: 10: 11) sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row.

Cast off rem 7 (7: 6: 6: 7) sts.

With RS facing, rejoin appropriate yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 23 (25: 25: 27: 27) sts, K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

## FRONT

Work as given for back until 20 (20: 20: 22: 22) rows less have been worked than on back to start of shoulder shaping, ending with a WS row.

Shape neck

Keeping stripes correct, cont as folls:

**Next row (RS):** K27 (27: 28: 29: 30) and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 4 rows, then on foll 3 (3: 3: 4: 4) alt rows, then on foll 4th row. 19 (19: 20: 20: 21) sts.

Work 5 rows, ending with a WS row.

## Shape shoulder

Cast off 6 (6: 7: 7: 7) sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem 7 (7: 6: 6: 7) sts.

With RS facing, rejoin appropriate yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 15 (17: 17: 17: 17) sts, K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

### SLEEVES (both alike)

Cast on 45 (45: 47: 49: 49) sts using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A.

**Row 1 (RS):** K0 (0: 0: 1: 1), P1 (1: 2: 2: 2), \*K3, P2, rep from \* to last 4 (4: 0: 1: 1) sts, K3 (3: 0: 1: 1), P1 (1: 0: 0: 0).

**Row 2:** P0 (0: 0: 1: 1), K1 (1: 2: 2: 2), \*P3, K2, rep from \* to last 4 (4: 0: 1: 1) sts, P3 (3: 0: 1: 1), K1 (1: 0: 0: 0).

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 18 rows, end with a WS row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg with a K row and a further 2 rows using yarn A, work in striped st as given for back, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 3rd and every foll 8th row to 65 (61: 63: 69: 63) sts, then on every foll 6th row until there are 71 (73: 75: 77: 79) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 42 (43: 43: 44: 44) cm, ending after same stripe row as on back and front to beg of armhole shaping and with a WS row.

### Shape top

Cast off 4 (5: 5: 6: 6) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 63 (63: 65: 65: 67) sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, then on foll 3 alt rows, then on every foll 4th row until 41 (41: 43: 43: 45) sts rem.

Work 1 row, ending with a WS row.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row until 33 sts rem, then on foll 3 rows, ending with a WS row. Cast off rem 27 sts.

### MAKING UP

Press.

Join right shoulder seam using back stitch, or mattress st if preferred.

### Collar

With RS facing, using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A, pick up and knit 25 (26: 26: 27: 27) sts down left side of neck, 15 (17: 17: 17: 17) sts from front, 25 (26: 26: 27: 27) sts up right side of neck, then 32 (33: 33: 36: 36) sts from back. 97 (102: 102: 107: 107) sts.

Row 1 (WS): K2, \*P3, K2, rep from \* to end.

Row 2: P2, \*K3, P2, rep from \* to end.

Rep these 2 rows until collar measures 10 cm.

Cast off in rib.

Set in sleeves using the set-in method.

Using photograph as a guide, sew on buttons using contrast colour embroidery threads.
