#### Cotton Glacé and Silkystones

#### NEEDLES

1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles 1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) circular needle, at least 120 cm long Cable needle

**BUTTONS** – 7 x BN1367 (22mm) from Bedecked. Please see information page for contact details.

#### TENSION

24 sts and 40 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 4mm (US 6) needles.

#### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**C2B** = slip next st onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K1, then K1 from cable needle; **C2F** = slip next st onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K1, then K1 from cable needle; **wyab** = with yarn at back (WS) of work; **wyaf** = with yarn at front (WS) of work.

#### BACK

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A cast on 124 [132: 140: 146: 152: 158: 166] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K0 [1: 2: 2: 2: 0], \*P1, K2, rep from \* to last 1 [2: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1] sts, P1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1], K0 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 0]. **Row 2:** P0 [1: 2: 2: 2: 2: 0], **\***K1, P2, rep from **\*** to last 1 [2: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1] sts, K1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1], P0 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 0]. These 2 rows form rib. Work in rib for a further 8 rows, ending with RS facing for next row Change to 4mm (US 6) needles. Next row (RS): Knit. Next row: Purl. Join in yarn B and now work in patt as folls: **Row 1 (RS):** Using yarn B K2 [3: 1: 1: 1: 1: 2], (sl 1 wyab, K2) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0] times, \*K2, sl 2 wyab, K2, rep from \* to last 5 [3: 1: 4: 1: 4: 2] sts, (K2, sl 1 wyab) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0] times, K2 [3: 1: 1: 1: 1: 2]. Row 2: Using yarn B K2 [3: 1: 1: 1: 1: 2], (sl 1 wyaf, P1, K1) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0] times, \*K1, P1, sl 2 wyaf, P1, K1, rep from \* to last 5 [3: 1: 4: 1: 4: 2] sts, (K1, P1, sl 1 wyaf) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0] times, K2 [3: 1: 1: 1: 1: 2]. **Row 3:** Using yarn A K2 [3: 1: 1: 1: 2], (C2F, K1) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1:0] times, \*K1, C2B, C2F, K1, rep from \* to last 5 [3:1:4:1:4:2] sts, (K1, C2B) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0] times, K2 [3: 1: 1: 1: 1: 2]. Row 4: Using yarn A purl. These 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until back meas 42 [43: 45: 43: 43: 42: 44] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape armholes

Keeping patt correct, cast off 7 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

110 [118: 126: 132: 138: 144: 152] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on foll 6 alt rows, then on 2 foll 4th rows. 84 [92: 100: 106: 112: 118: 126] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 21 [23: 24: 26: 28: 29: 30] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape shoulders and back neck

**Next row (RS):** Cast off 2 [3: 3: 4: 4: 5] sts, patt until there are 28 [30: 34: 35: 38: 40: 43] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 10 rows **and at same time** cast off 3 [3: 4: 4: 4: 5: 5] sts at beg of 2nd and foll 4 [3: 4: 4: 1: 4: 2] alt rows,

then -[4:-:-:5:-:6] sts at beg of foll -[1:-:-:3:-:2] alt rows.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off rem 3 [4: 4: 5: 5: 5: 6] sts.

With RS facing, slip centre 24 [26: 26: 28: 28: 30: 30] sts onto a holder, rejoin appropriate yarn and patt to end. Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

POCKET LININGS (make 2)

Using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A cast on 32 [32: 32: 35: 35: 38: 38] sts.

Beg with a K row, work in st st for 17 cm, inc 1 st at each end of last row and ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and leave 34 [34: 34: 37: 37: 40: 40] sts on a holder.

#### LEFT FRONT

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A cast on 60 [64: 68: 71: 74: 77: 81] sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K0 [1: 2: 2: 2: 0], \*P1, K2, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** K1, P1, **\***K1, P2, rep from **\*** to last 1 [2: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1] sts, K1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1], P0 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 0].

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 8 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Next row: Purl.

Join in yarn B and now work in patt as folls:

**Row 1 (RS):** Using yarn B K2 [3: 1: 1: 1: 2], (sl 1 wyab, K2) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0] times, \*K2, sl 2 wyab, K2, rep from \* to last st, K1. **Row 2:** Using yarn B K1, \*K1, P1, sl 2 wyaf, P1, K1, rep from \* to last 5 [3: 1: 4: 1: 4: 2] sts, (K1, P1, sl 1 wyaf) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0] times, K2 [3: 1: 1: 1: 2].

**Row 3:** Using yarn A K2 [3: 1: 1: 1: 2], (C2F, K1) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0] times, **\***K1, C2B, C2F, K1, rep from **\*** to last st, K1.

Row 4: Using yarn A purl.

These 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until left front meas approx 20 cm, ending after patt row 4 and with RS facing for next row.

#### Place pocket

**Next row (RS):** Patt 12 [16: 14: 17: 17: 15] sts, slip next 34 [34: 34: 37: 37: 40: 40] sts onto a holder and, in their place, patt across 34 [34: 34: 37: 37: 40: 40] sts of first pocket lining, patt 14 [14: 20: 20: 20: 20: 20: 26] sts.

Cont straight until left front matches back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape armhole

Keeping patt correct, cast off 7 sts at beg of next row. 53 [57: 61: 64: 67: 70: 74] sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at armhole edge of next 5 rows, then on foll 2 alt rows. 46 [50: 54: 57: 60: 63: 67] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape front slope

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at end (front slope edge) of next and foll 8 [6: 4: 2: 0: 0: 0] alt rows, then on 11 [14: 16: 19: 19: 20: 18] foll 4th rows, then on 0 [0: 0: 0: 2: 2: 4] foll 6th rows **and at same time** dec 1 st at armhole edge of next and foll 3 alt rows, then on 2 foll 4th rows. 20 [23: 27: 29: 32: 34: 38] sts.

Cont straight until left front matches back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape shoulder

Cast off 2 [3: 3: 4: 4: 5] sts at beg of next and foll 0 [4: 0: 5: 2: 0: 3] alt rows, then 3 [4: 4: -: 5: 5: 6] sts at beg of foll 5 [1: 5: -: 3: 5: 2] alt rows. Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 3 [4: 4: 5: 5: 5: 6] sts.

#### RIGHT FRONT

Using 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>mm (US 3) needles and yarn A cast on 60 [64: 68: 71: 74: 77: 81] sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*P1, K2, rep from \* to last 1 [2: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1] sts, P1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1], K0 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 0].

**Row 2:** P0 [1: 2: 2: 2: 0], **\***K1, P2, rep from **\*** to last 3 sts, K1, P1, K1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 8 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Next row: Purl.

Join in yarn B and now work in patt as folls:

**Row 1 (RS):** Using yarn B K1, \*K2, sl 2 wyab, K2, rep from \* to last 5 [3: 1: 4: 1: 4: 2] sts, (K2, sl 1 wyab) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0] times, K2 [3: 1: 1: 1: 2].

**Row 2:** Using yarn B K2 [3: 1: 1: 1: 1: 2], (sl 1 wyaf, P1, K1) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0] times, \*K1, P1, sl 2 wyaf, P1, K1, rep from \* to last st, K1. **Row 3:** Using yarn A K1, \*K1, C2B, C2F, K1, rep from \* to last 5 [3: 1: 4: 1: 4: 2] sts, (K1, C2B) 1 [0: 0: 1: 0: 1: 0] times, K2 [3: 1: 1: 1: 1: 2].

Row 4: Using yarn A purl.

These 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until right front meas approx 20 cm, ending after patt row 4 and with RS facing for next row.

#### Place pocket

**Next row (RS):** Patt 14 [14: 20: 20: 20: 20: 26] sts, slip next 34 [34: 34: 37: 37: 40: 40] sts onto a holder and, in their place, patt across 34 [34: 34: 37: 37: 40: 40] sts of second pocket lining, patt 12 [16: 14: 14: 17: 17: 15] sts.

Complete to match left front, reversing shapings.

#### SLEEVES

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A cast on 62 [64: 68: 68: 70: 70: 72] sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2 [0: 2: 2: 0: 0: 1], \*P1, K2, rep from \* to last 0 [1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 2] sts, P0 [1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 1], K0 [0: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1].

**Row 2:** P2 [0: 2: 2: 0: 0: 1], \*K1, P2, rep from \* to last 0 [1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 2] sts, K0 [1: 0: 0: 1: 1: 1], P0 [0: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1].

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 10 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Next row: Purl.

Join in yarn B and now work in patt as folls:

**Row 1 (RS):** Using yarn B K1 [2: 1: 1: 2: 2: 0], (sl 1 wyab, K2) 1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1] times, \*K2, sl 2 wyab, K2, rep from \* to last 4 [5: 1: 1: 2: 2: 3] sts, (K2, sl 1 wyab) 1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1] times, K1 [2: 1: 1: 2: 2: 0]. **Row 2:** Using yarn B K1 [2: 1: 1: 2: 2: 0], (sl 1 wyaf, P1, K1) 1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1] times, \*K1, P1, sl 2 wyaf, P1, K1, rep from \* to last 4 [5: 1: 1: 2: 2: 3] sts, (K1, P1, sl 1 wyaf) 1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1] times, K1 [2: 1: 1: 2: 2: 0].

**Row 3:** Using yarn A K1 [2: 1: 1: 2: 2: 0], (C2F, K1) 1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1] times, **\***K1, C2B, C2F, K1, rep from **\*** to last 4 [5: 1: 1: 2: 2: 3] sts, (K1, C2B) 1 [1: 0: 0: 0: 0: 1] times, K1 [2: 1: 1: 2: 2: 0].

#### Row 4: Using yarn A purl.

These 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 3rd [3rd: 5th: 3rd: 3rd: 3rd: 3rd] and every foll 10th [10th: 12th: 10th: 10th: 10th: 10th] row to 78 [80: 92: 80: 90: 102: 100] sts, then on every foll 12th [12th: 14th: 12th: 12th: 12th: 12th] row until there are 90 [94: 96: 100: 104: 106: 108] sts, taking inc sts into patt.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 47 [50: 52: 54: 55: 55] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### Shape top

Keeping patt correct, cast off 7 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 76 [80: 82: 86: 90: 92: 94] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, then on foll 4 alt rows, then on 9 foll 4th rows. 44 [48: 50: 54: 58: 60: 62] sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row until 40 sts rem, then on foll 7 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. 26 sts.

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 16 sts.

#### MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

#### Front band

With RS facing, using 3¼mm (US 3) circular needle and yarn A, beg and ending at front cast-on edges, pick up and knit 108 [110: 115: 110: 108: 112] sts up right front opening edge to beg of front slope shaping, 55 [60: 63: 68: 73: 76: 79] sts up right front slope, and 11 sts down right side of back neck, K across 24 [26: 26: 28: 28: 30: 30] sts on back holder inc [-: dec: -: dec: inc: dec] 1 [-: 1: -: 1: 1: 1] st at centre, then pick up and knit 11 sts up left side of back neck, 55 [60: 63: 68: 73: 76: 79] sts down left front slope to beg of front slope shaping, and 108 [110: 115: 110: 110: 108: 112] sts down left front opening edge. 373 [388: 403: 406: 415: 421: 433] sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** K1, \*P2, K1, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2**: K3, **\***P1, K2, rep from **\*** to last st, K1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 2 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

**Row 5 (WS):** Rib 3 [4: 3: 4: 4: 3: 5], \*work 2 tog, yrn (to make a buttonhole), rib 15 [15: 16: 15: 15: 15: 15], rep from \* 5 times more, work 2 tog, yrn (to make 7th buttonhole), rib to end.

Work in rib for a further 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.


#### Pocket tops (both alike)

Slip 34 [34: 34: 37: 37: 40: 40] sts on pocket holder onto 3¼mm (US 3) needles and rejoin yarn A with RS facing.

Beg with row 2, work in rib as given for front band for 10 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

See information page for finishing instructions, setting in sleeves using the set-in method.
