## NEEDLES

1 pair $311 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (no 10) (US 3) needles
1 pair 4 mm (no 8) (US 6) needles
3114 mm (no 10) (US 3) circular needle, 120 cm long
BUTTONS $-3 \times 20 \mathrm{~mm}$ size metal buttons and $6 \times 15 \mathrm{~mm}$ size metal buttons

## TENSION

21 sts and 39 rows to 10 cm measured over moss st patt using 4 mm (US 6) needles.

## BACK

Using 4 mm (US 6) needles, cast on 15 [25:37:51:65] sts.
Row 1 (RS): ${ }^{\star} \mathrm{K} 1, \mathrm{P} 1$, rep from ${ }^{\star}$ to last st, K1.
This row is repeated to form moss st patt.
Keeping patt correct, inc 1 st at each end of next row, then cast on 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, then cast on 3 sts at beg of next 24 rows, working inc sts in patt. 97 [107: 119: 133: 147] sts.
Work 40 [44: 48:52:56] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.
Next row (RS): Patt 20, sl 1, K1, psso, K2tog, patt to last 24 sts, sl 1, K1, psso, K2tog, patt 20.93 [103: 115: 129: 143] sts.
Working all decs as set by last row, dec 2 sts at each side of 2 foll $10^{\text {th }}$ rows. 85 [95: 107: 121: 135] sts.
Work 9 rows straight, ending with RS facing for next row.
** Next row (RS): Patt 20, (K1, P1 into next st) twice, patt to last 22 sts, (P1, K1 into next st) twice, patt 20. $\star \star \star$ 89 [99: 111: 125: 139] sts.
Work 13 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.
Rep from $\star \star$ to ${ }^{\star \star \star} .93$ [103: 115: 129: 143] sts.
Work 15 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.
Inc 1 st at each end of next row. 95 [105:117: 131:145] sts
Cont straight until back meas 35.5 [36.5: $37.5: 38.5: 39.5] \mathrm{cm}$ (measured at side seam), ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape armholes

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 [4:5:6:7] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 89 [97: 107: 119: 131] sts.
Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 [7:9:11:13] rows, then on 3 [3:3:4: 4] foll alt rows, then on foll $4^{\text {th }}$ row. 71 [75: 81: 87: 95] sts.
Cont straight until armhole meas 20 [21 22: 23: 24] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape shoulders

Cast off $5[5: 6: 7: 8]$ sts at beg of next 2 rows, then $5[6: 6: 7: 8]$ sts at beg of foll 2 rows, then $5[6: 7: 8: 9]$ sts at beg of foll 2 rows.
41 [41: 43: 43: 45] sts.
Dec 1 st at each end of next and 2 foll alt rows. 35 [35:37:37:39] sts. Work 9 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.
Cast off.

## LEFT FRONT

Using 4 mm (US 6) needles, cast on 3 sts.
Work 1 row in moss st patt, ending with WS facing for next row.
Cast on 4 sts at beg (front edge) of next row and at same edge on 4 [4:5:7:8] foll alt rows, then 3 sts at beg of 2 [3:3:2:3] foll alt rows, then 2 sts at beg of $2[3: 4: 5: 5]$ foll alt rows, working inc sts in patt and ending with RS facing for next row. 33 [38:44:51:58] sts. Inc 1 st at front edge of next row, then at same edge on foll 10 rows. 44 [49: 55: 62: 69] sts.
Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Inc 1 st at front edge of next row and at same edge on 4 foll alt rows. 49 [54: 60: 67:74] sts.
Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.
Next row (RS): (Side edge) Patt 20, sl 1, K1, psso, K2tog, patt to last st, inc in last st. 48 [53:59: 66:73] sts.
Inc 1 st at front edge on 2 foll alt rows, then on foll $4^{\text {th }}$ row. 51 [56: 62: 69:76] sts.
Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.
Next row (RS): Patt 20, sl 1, K1, psso, K2tog, patt to end.
49 [54: 60: 67:74] sts.
Inc 1 st at front edge on $2^{\text {nd }}$ row, then on foll $4^{\text {th }}$ row.
51 [56: 62: 69: 76] sts.
Work 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.
Next row (RS): Patt 20, sl 1, K1, psso, K2tog, patt to last st, inc in last st. 50 [55: 61: 68:75] sts.
Inc 1 st at front edge on foll $4^{\text {th }}$ row. 51 [56: 62: 69:76] sts.
Work 5 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.
Next row (RS): Patt 20, (K1, P1 into next st) twice, patt to last st, inc in last st. 54 [59: 65: 72: 79] sts.
Inc 1 st at front edge on 2 foll $6^{\text {th }}$ rows. 56 [61:67:74: 81] sts.
Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.
Next row (RS): Patt 20, (K1, P1 into next st) twice, patt to end.
58 [63: 69: 76: 83] sts.
Inc 1 st at front edge on foll $6^{\text {th }}$ row, then inc 1 st at side edge on foll $10^{\text {th }}$ row. 60 [65: 71: 78: 85] sts.
Cont patt until left front matches back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape armhole

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 [4:5:6:7] sts at beg of next row. 57 [61: 66: 72:78] sts.
Work 1 row.
Dec 1 st at armhole edge of next 5 [7:9:11:13] rows, then on 3 [3:3:4:4] foll alt rows, then on foll $4^{\text {th }}$ row. 48 [50:53:56:60] sts. Cont straight until left front matches back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape shoulder

Cast off $5[5: 6: 7: 8]$ sts at beg of next row, $5[6: 6: 7: 8]$ sts at beg of foll alt row and $5[6: 7: 8: 9]$ sts at beg of foll alt row.
33 [33:34: 34:35] sts.
Dec 1 st at shoulder edge of $2^{\text {nd }}$ row, then on 2 foll alt rows. 30 [30:31:31:32] sts.
Next row (WS): Cast off 22 [22: 23: 23:24] sts, patt to end. 8 sts. Dec 1 st at end (neck edge) of next row and at same edge on foll 5 row. 2 sts.
Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.
Mark position for 3 buttons - first to come 8 cm down from castoff edge, last to come 20 cm down from cast-off edge and rem button evenly spaced between.

## RIGHT FRONT

Using 4 mm (US 6) needles, cast on 3 sts.
Work 1 row in patt, ending with WS facing for next row.
Cast on 4 sts at end (front edge) of next row and at same edge on 4 [4:5:7:8] foll alt rows, then 3 sts at end of 2 [3:3:2:3] foll alt rows, then 2 sts at end of 2 [ $3: 4: 5: 5$ ] foll alt rows, working inc sts in patt and ending with RS facing for next row. 33 [38:44:51:58] sts. Inc 1 st at front edge of next row, then at same edge on foll 10 rows. 44 [49: 55: 62: 69] sts.
Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.
Inc 1 st at front edge of next row and at same edge on 4 foll alt rows.

49 [54: 60: 67:74] sts.
Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.
Next row (RS): Inc in first st, patt to last 24 sts, sl 1, K1, psso, K2tog, patt 20. 48 [53: 59: 66:73] sts.
Complete to match left front reversing shapings and working 3 buttonholes to correspond with markers as folls:
Buttonhole row (RS): Patt 6, cast off 2 sts (to make a buttonhole - cast on 2 sts over these cast-off sts on next row), patt to end.

## SLEEVES

## Left sleeve only

Using 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 33 [35: 37: 37: 39] sts.
Work 4 rows in moss st patt, ending with RS facing for next row.
*Buttonhole row (RS): Patt 2, cast off 2 sts (to make a buttonhole - cast on 2 sts over these cast-off sts on next row), patt to end.

Work 11 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. **
Work from ${ }^{\star}$ to ${ }^{\star \star}$ twice more.
Break off yarn and leave these sts on a spare needle.
Using 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 9 sts.
Work 40 rows in patt, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Join sections

Next row (RS): Patt 6 sts, holding 3 rem sts behind 33 [35:37:37:
39] sts left on spare needle, (patt tog 1 st from spare needle with 1 st from needle) 3 times, patt to end across rem sts from spare needle. 39 [41: 43: 43: 45] sts.
Right sleeve only
Using 4 mm (US 6) needles, cast on 9 sts.
Work 40 rows in moss st patt, ending with RS facing for next row. Break off yarn and leave these sts on a spare needle.
Using 4 mm (US 6) needles, cast on 33 [35:37:37:39] sts.
Work 4 rows in patt, ending with RS facing for next row.
*Buttonhole row (RS): Patt to last 4 sts, cast off 2 sts (to make a buttonhole - cast on 2 sts over these cast-off sts on next row), patt to end.
Work 11 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. $\star \star$
Work from ${ }^{\star}$ to ${ }^{\star \star}$ twice more.

## Join sections

Next row (RS): Patt 30 [32:34:34:36], holding 9 sts left on spare needle behind 3 sts on left needle, (patt tog 1 st from left needle with 1 st from spare needle) 3 times, patt to end across rem sts from spare needle.
39 [41: 43: 43: 45] sts.

## Both sleeves

Cont in patt shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of $6^{\text {th }}$ and every foll $8^{\text {th }}\left[6^{\text {th }}: 6^{\text {th }}: 6^{\text {th }}: 6^{\text {th }}\right]$ row to 69 [47:53: 69:79] sts, then on every foll - [ $\left.8^{\text {th. }}: 8^{\text {th }}: 8^{\text {th. }}: 8^{\text {th }}\right]$ row until there are $-[73: 77: 81: 85]$ sts, working inc sts in patt.
Cont straight until sleeve meas 45 [46: 47: 47: 47] cm from cast-on edges, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape top

Cast off 3 [4:5:6:7] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 63 [65: 67: 69:71] sts. Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, then on 8 [10:11:11:11] foll $4^{\text {th }}$ rows, then on 5 [2:2:3:4] foll alt rows, then on every row until 21 sts rem.

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows.
Cast off rem 11 sts.

## MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page in FAQ area.
Join shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

## Neckband

With RS facing, using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (US 3) needles, pick up and knit 95 [95: 99: 99: 103] sts all around neck edge, beg and ending at front opening edges.
Work 4 rows in g st, ending with $\mathbf{W S}$ facing for next row.
Cast off knitwise on WS.

## Front and lower edging

With RS facing, using $311 / \mathrm{mm}$ (US 3) circular needle, beg and ending at top of neckband, pick up and knit 78 [80: 82: 85: 87] sts down left front edge to beg of shaped edge, 74 [79: 85: 92: 101] sts from shaped front edge, 101 [111: 123: 137: 151] sts from shaped back edge, 74 [79: 85: 92: 101] sts from shaped front edge and 78 [80: 82: 85: 87] sts up right front edge.

45 [46: 47: 47: 47] cm
(171⁄2 [18: $181 / 2: 181 / 2: 18]$ in)

Work 4 rows in g st, ending with WS facing for next row.
Cast off knitwise on WS.
